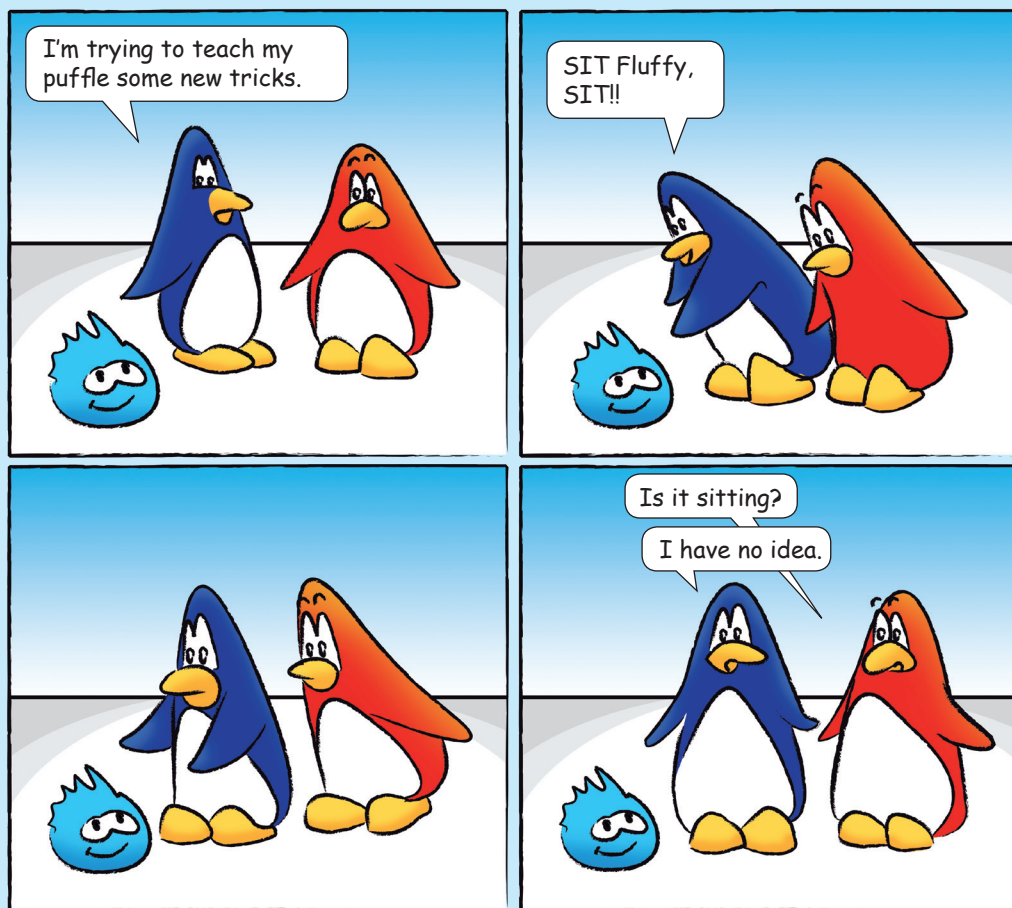
Je werkt in deze module vooral aan de volgende onderdelen:

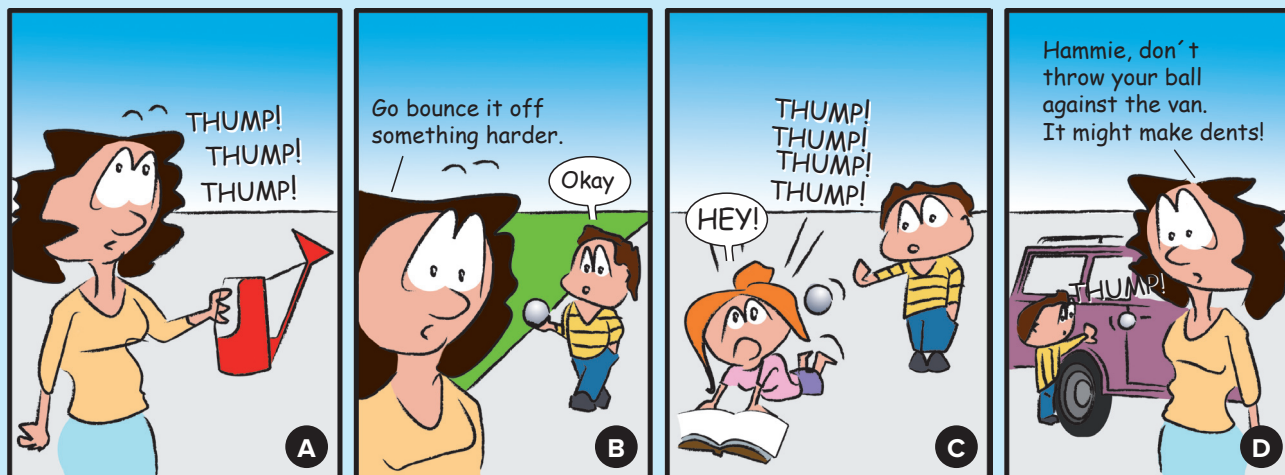

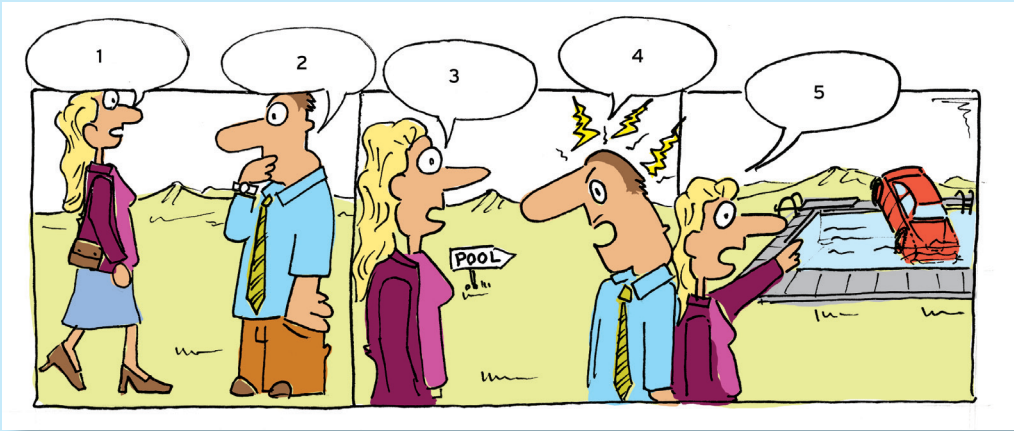
